

Request for Proposals for School Uniform

The Museum School of Avondale Estates is seeking a high-quality school uniform vendor.

About The Museum School:

Mission Statement: To inspire students, teachers, and the community to collaborate to develop strong critical thinking, interpersonal, and academic skills in our students, which will prepare them for real-world success. The school's core values are respect, responsibility, cooperation, creativity, kindness, and sustainability.

<u>The Museum School (TMS)</u> is a DeKalb County charter school, serving 588 Kindergarten – 8th grade students. In its 14th year of operation, TMS is built on the museum model, a model that fosters exploration and discovery, giving students a strong sense of autonomy, interdependence, motivation and a joy for learning. The museum school model is based on the idea that children learn best through personal exploration and hands-on experience. The school partners with museums and other learning institutions to provide real-life experiences with classroom topics. Interactive learning expeditions to partner sites offer students a chance to ask questions, make observations, reflect on experiences and draw their own conclusions.

About The Museum School's Uniform Program:

The Museum School's <u>uniform policy</u> requires students to purchase one TMS <u>logo</u> polo directly from the school's selected vendor for bi-weekly learning expeditions. Learning expedition uniforms are light blue, logo polo with navy bottoms or navy, logo polo with khaki bottoms. The school's specific plaid must also be purchased from the selected vendor. Other uniform pieces may be purchased from families' vendor of choice.

The school convenes a Uniform Task Force every 5-6 years to review the school's uniform policy and to initiate the procurement process for a school uniform vendor. The Task Force is made up of TMS staff members and parents. Ultimately, the Task Force's role is to review stakeholder feedback and vendor proposals and make recommendations to The Museum School's Principal on suggested uniform policy edits and a uniform vendor.

The school's Kindergarten – 8th grade students wear sizes 4T – Adult XXL.

Our Request:

TMS is looking for a school uniform vendor that offers a variety of high-quality uniform pieces at a fair price and within a reasonable time frame.

Proposals Features:

Within the proposal, please include the following information:

- Detailed information on sizing options (including adjustable waistbands, husky fit, petite fit, female-fit, etc.)
- Detailed information on material options (adaptive clothing, performance polos, mesh polos, pique polos, interlock polos, skirt and pant options, etc.)

• Pricing Details

- Typical, non-sale cost of:
 - o Youth polo shirt (with and without logo) performance, mesh, pique, and interlock
 - o Adult polo shirt (with and without logo) performance, mesh, pique, and interlock
